Fundraiser Rules

1. All ages who know how to skate will be allowed to participate
2. Every skater is required to have their own skates and a CSA approved helmet. If you do not have skates and would like to participate please contact a member of the Winter Carnival committee and we will assist.
3. Skaters may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheet.
4. Pledges may be made by anyone.
5. Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, phone number and pledge (either by minute or base pledge) skater may collect the flat amount pledges in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.

6. On skate-a-thon day each participant will be able to skate between 7pm and 11 pm. Each participant will check in prior to skating and will be issued a time sheet to keep track of the minutes they are actively skating during the fundraiser. The skater has a maximum of 180 minutes to skate.
7. Upon completion of the skate-a-thon skaters will hand in their time sheets. A volunteer will record each skater's time total on their pledge sheet and return it. Skaters may then collect outstanding pledges. Please return pledge sheets with the money you have raised no later than Tuesday February 27, 2018. Or donations can be dropped off at the Grunthal Arena Canteen on Tuesday February 27 between 4 and 8 pm.
8. The skate-a-thon is open to the public. Admission is \$10. Anyone who raises \$50 or more will obtain **FREE** entrance. A donation bucket will be set up at the door.
9. There will be **two prizes** awarded. First for the most money raised and second for the most amount of time skated. In the off chance that there is a tie, the names will be put in to a bucket and one winner will be randomly pulled.
